The Faculty of Science (FoS), in cooperation with the Academic Club, Chiang Mai University is pleased to announce its famous annual Science Camp Activity. This year, our 2020 CMU Science Camp will be boosted up to another level where selected applicants will be partially sponsored by the FoS and its partners. Science Camp attendees will experience advanced scientific research and study more closely with award-winning scientists and professors. Participants will also have an opportunity to discover various science disciplines, including careers in science, mathematics and technology, offered by eight departments of the FoS. This year, our 2020 CMU Science Camp's theme is "Unlocking the Nature" where we attempt to keep its detail secret until you visit us.

1. SCIENCE CAMP'S DURATION AND LOCATION

2. EXAMPLES OF ACTIVITIES DURING SCIENCE CAMP

- In-depth introduction to the FoS and its various scientific disciplines as well as career path delineation after graduation.
- Meet & greet with award-winning young scientists, experience inspirational talk and discussion on how it feels like being a scientist.
- Research skill practice, experimental design and implementation under close supervision from faculty members.
- Visit eight backbone departments of the FoS and explore outstanding research with hands on experience.
- And, many more extracurricular and recreational activities, etc.

3. BENEFITS OF ATTENDEES

Upon completion of the 2020 CMU Science Camp, students will receive *Certificate of Participation* to accompany their portfolio used for the application for admission to the FoS, Chiang Mai University under the Thai University Center Admission System (or TCAS #1: Application based on portfolio).

4. AVAILABILITY AND SELECTION PROCESS

Students currently in Grade 10 and 11[†] (in Science and Mathematics Program, if applicable) are eligible to apply for this upcoming Science Camp. **Eighty** (80) students will be selected based on their academic records and their essays presented in the application form. The selection consensus by the FoS is ultimate and cannot be disputed.

5. QUALIFICATION

- 1) Current students (enrolled in Grade 11 or 12, as of May 2020) who are interested in Science and Mathematics may be eligible for application.
- 2) Students should not hold any criminal record nor detained from school's activities.
- 3) Cumulative Grade-Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher.
- 4) Selected applicants must be able to attend all activities during Science Camp.

As of May 2020, students should either be enrolled in Grade 11 or 12.
