



Announcement of the Faculty of Science, Chiang Mai University
Applications Open for the “2026 CMU Science Camp”

The Faculty of Science (FoS), in cooperation with the Academic Club, Chiang Mai University is pleased to announce its famous annual Science Camp Activity. This year, our 2026 CMU Science Camp will be boosted up to another level where selected applicants will be partially sponsored by the FoS and its partners. Science Camp attendees will experience advanced scientific research and study more closely with award-winning scientists and professors. Participants will also have an opportunity to discover various science disciplines, including careers in science, mathematics and technology, offered by eight departments of the FoS.

To achieve the objectives of this initiative, the FoS is pleased to announce the opening of applications for students to participate in the 2026 CMU Science Camp. The details are as follows:

1. Qualifications

- 1) Current students (currently in Grade 10 or 11) who are interested in Science and Mathematics may be eligible for application.
- 2) Cumulative Grade-Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher.
- 3) Students should not have any criminal record, nor have been suspended from school activities, and should possess an interest in science.
- 4) Selected applicants must be able to attend all activities during Science Camp.

2. Examples of activities during CMU Science Camp

- In-depth introduction to the FoS and its various scientific disciplines as well as career path delineation after graduation.
- Share experiences and inspire students in learning science.
- Activities to enhance research skills, analysis, and experimental design under the close guidance of faculty members from the Faculty of Science.
- Visit 8 departments of the Faculty of Science, including the Departments of Mathematics, Chemistry, Industrial Chemistry, Biology, Geology, Physics and Materials Science, Computer Science, and Statistics.
- Study the key research in each discipline and participate in hands-on activities to practice research, experiments, and academic tasks.

3. Benefits of attendees

Upon completion of the 2026 CMU Science Camp, students will receive **Certificate of Participation** to accompany their portfolio used for the application for admission to the FoS, Chiang Mai University under the Thai University Center Admission System (or TCAS1: Application based on portfolio).

4. Availability and selection process

Students currently in Grade 10 or 11 (in Science and Mathematics Program, if applicable) are eligible to apply for this upcoming Science Camp. Eighty (80) students will be selected based on their academic records and their essays presented in the application form. The selection consensus by the FoS is ultimate and cannot be disputed.

5. CMU Science Camp's duration and location

April 20-25, 2026 (6 Days 5 Night) at the Faculty of Science, Chiang Mai University

6. Fees

1) Application Fees

Note:

- 1) The participation fee for the camp is 2,400 THB, which covers the following expenses for the entire camp: hotel accommodation for 5 nights, 16 meals, 11 snack meals, 1 camp shirt, and laboratory equipment used during the camp.
- 2) Selected participants from families with a monthly income of less than 5,000 baht may submit documentation to request a waiver of the participation fee. The family's income must be officially certified by a government authority. The selection consensus by the FoS is ultimate and cannot be disputed.

7. Application procedures & Required Document

7.1 Complete online application form at <http://scicamp.science.cmu.ac.th/>

7.2 Print the completed application form, affix full frontal view of recent photo and sign the form.
(Note: both applicant and legal guardian must approve and sign the application form)

7.3 Download the Essay question form and write your response by your handwriting.

7.4 Upload the Application Fee's transfer receipt (150.-THB/person) at <http://scicamp.science.cmu.ac.th/> and print it to attach with the application form.
